

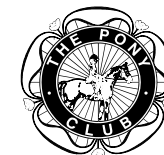
RULES

1. The event will be run under The Pony Club Rules 2008 for Cross Country and Show Jumping
2. Neither the organiser, nor any person acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, or any other persons or property whatsoever in connection with this event.
3. **Health and Safety:** the organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
4. **Hats:** Competitors are required to produce hats at the secretary's desk when collecting their number. Hats must be tagged in accordance with current British standards (PAS 015, BS EN 1384, SNELL E2201, AS/N25 3838 1998 or AS/N25 3838 2003). Competitors may not compete without a tagged hat and must wear this at all times when mounted with the chinstrap fastened. A jockey skull to the correct standard must be worn for all XC at 0.80m and above, plus it is strongly recommended that skulls are worn for all XC.
5. Back protectors to approved standard to be worn for Cross Country phase.
6. Medical Armbands are compulsory for the Cross Country phase.
7. Jackets must be worn by competitors for the Show Jumping phase.
8. No earrings or visible piercings may be worn.
9. The judge's decision is final in all matters. The committee reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the conditions or competitions as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion.
10. No entry fee will be refunded without the production of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
11. In the event of cancellation prior to the event a £5.00 administration charge will be made. If the event is cancelled on the day there will be no refund.
12. Entries will be limited and will not be accepted by telephone.
13. Horses and ponies may only enter one class - plus the Pairs.
14. All Pony Club members not holding a 'B' Test Certificate must produce a letter of permission from their DC allowing spurs to be worn.

Competitors will Show Jump **before** the Cross Country phase and times will be given for both. The height of the Show Jumping course will be the same in each class as the Cross Country course.

CLASS 1 MINIMUS

Combination of horse/pony and rider never to have been placed 1st in any event involving cross country, excluding minimus classes. Fences approximately 0.69m (2'3")

Section A: Riders under 13 years (age on day of event)

Section B: Riders over 13 years

Entry fee: £27.50

CLASS 2 NOVICE

Fences approximately 0.75-0.85m (2'6"-2'9")

Section A: Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have been placed 1st-3rd in a cross country event at novice, intermediate or open level (Depending on nos. of entries this section may be split according to age)

Section B: Open

Entry fee: £27.50

CLASS 3 PAIRS

Fences approximately 0.75-0.85m (2'6"-2'9")

Entry fee: £40.00 per pair

CLASS 4 INTERMEDIATE OPEN

Fences maximum 0.92m (3')

Entry fee: £27.50

Rosettes to 8th place in each class or section.

Winners of each class or section will receive a trophy (sponsored by **Altis Industries**) and a photo voucher (sponsored by **Photo Synergy**)

£5 deposit for number cloth – send a separate cheque for each rider/horse combination and for each class, with entry form – this will be refundable on the day when number cloth is returned, or withheld should the event be cancelled. JUDGING:

In the case of equality the least jumping penalties Show Jumping and Cross Country - combined - **plus** nearest the 'Bogey Time' in the Cross Country will determine results.

CROSS COUNTRY

Competitors are eliminated after 3 refusals at one jump, or 4 refusals over whole course. They may continue - giving way to other riders - unless asked to leave the course by a Petersfield official steward/jump judge.

NOTE

Failure to report 15 mins before the correct times for Show Jumping and Cross Country will mean the rider risks elimination.

A tack check will be in operation before each phase. Please make sure all stitching is sound. Hats must be tagged and must be checked at secretary's desk when collecting number.

Directions to Fair Oak Estate:

Take A 272 to Rogate, turn down to Nyewood, next to church (small cross roads). Follow this small, hilly road for about 1/2 mile, then over small bridge. Immediately ahead is driveway entrance to Fair Oak.
