

## RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the WVRC, the organisers of the event nor any agent or representative thereof accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land owners or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
2. The show will be run under **Riding Club** rules. **BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE WORN.**
3. **Protective headgear**, to a minimum standard of BSI Kite marked PAS014 or BS EN1384, including a permanently fitted, non detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points must be worn by anyone mounted. PAS015 or ASTM F1163 are considered even safer. All such headgear must be worn with harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
4. **Medical Arm Bands are compulsory for the Cross Country phase.**
5. **No body piercing AT ALL.**
6. Entries will be processed on a first come, first served basis,
7. All classes will be strictly limited.
8. All entry fees must accompany entry forms. No entries will be accepted over the telephone. Entries, less an admin fee of £5, will be refunded on receipt of a Vet or Doctor's certificate.
9. Horses and ponies can be ridden only once in any class, and entered in a maximum of one class.
10. The decision of the judge will be FINAL in all matters and the Committee reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the conditions or competitions as they think fit and to refuse entries and to ask any person to leave the ground.
11. No competitor shall:  
*Ill treat in any way a horse at the show, whether inside or outside the arena; misuse or use excessively a whip or spur; deliberately use the action of the bit as a means of punishment and/or misuse any item of saddlery in a manner likely to cause pain or discomfort to the horse.*
12. Objections must be made direct to the Secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the relevant incident and must be accompanied by a deposit of £10 returnable if the objection is sustained. Please note that no video coverage will be accepted as evidence in support of an Objection.
13. In the event of cancellation of the show, entry fees will be returned less £5 per competitor to cover administrative expenses.
14. The age of a rider is determined as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008 for all classes being divided into age, and to compete as a junior you must not have reached the age of 17 before 1st Jan 2008.
